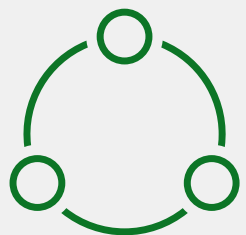


# Leniency Agreements: greater cooperation within the public administration



**On April 25th, 2025**, the Office of the Comptroller General (CGU), the Office of the Attorney General (AGU), and the Federal Prosecution Office (MPF) entered into a Technical Cooperation Agreement (ACT) aimed at strengthening Leniency Agreements in the fight against corruption.

The ACT seeks to improve legal certainty, predictability, and the effectiveness of leniency negotiations by:



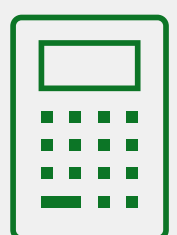
Coordinating the actions of CGU, AGU, and MPF while respecting the autonomy of each institution;



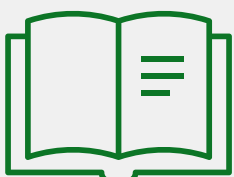
Establishing joint protocols for the negotiation, execution, and monitoring of leniency agreements;



Sharing information and technical data among the institutions;



Developing methodologies for calculating settlement amounts and exchanging best practices;



Studying potential regulatory amendments to improve the management of leniency agreements; and



Resolving possible conflicts between CGU, AGU, and MPF regarding executed leniency agreements.

The initial term of the Agreement is **five years** (until May 2030), with the possibility of extension.

This development underscores the importance of proper preparation for companies seeking to negotiate Leniency Agreements, particularly through the strengthening of Integrity Programs and the thorough assessment of legal and regulatory risks.
